

FAA Security Agreement with Air Charity Network Concerning Use of ICAO Three-letter Designator NGF and Telephony ANGEL FLIGHT for Third Party Flight Operations in Support of the Organization

Air Charity Network agrees to the following security requirements for use of the three-letter ICAO designator NGF, and telephony ANGEL FLIGHT, that Air Charity Network provides for use by third parties, i.e. to aircraft operating on behalf of Air Charity Network but not owned by Air Charity Network:

1. Air Charity Network's three-letter ICAO designator NGF must not be used for call signs by third party flights outside of airspace controlled by the United States except for certain NGF flights that operate in Canada and the Bahamas.
2. Air Charity Network's three-letter ICAO designator must not be used for flights of third party foreign registered aircraft.
3. Air Charity Network's three-letter ICAO designator must only be used for flights that directly support the organization's charitable mission that are recorded per item 6 below.
4. The FAA N registration number of the aircraft must always be included in the Remarks section of the flight plan.
5. Air Charity Network must maintain 24/7 points of contact for each region on the Air Charity Network Contact Us webpage (<http://aircharitynetwork.org/contact-us/>). These points of contact must be able to provide information to the FAA Domestic Events Network (DEN) Air Traffic Security Coordinator (ATSC) (9-AWA-ATS-ATASC@faa.gov) that may be needed regarding any flight using the NGF three-letter ICAO designator and ANGEL FLIGHT telephony, including the name of the pilot in command. The ATSC may need this information for lost communications, any other security reason, or search and rescue. Changes to the 24/7 point of contact information that are not updated on the Air Charity Network Contact Us webpage must be reported to FAA Air Traffic System Operations Security ATSC at 9-AWA-ATS-ATASC@faa.gov.
6. Air Charity Network must maintain records for the past 12 months that can provide FAA Air Traffic System Operations Security with the NGF flight numbers assigned to NGF pilots, contact information for NGF pilots, and available flight information associated with NGF flight numbers when requested by FAA Air Traffic System Operations Security.

Continued use of the three-letter ICAO designator NGF, and telephony ANGEL FLIGHT, by Air Charity Network for third party use is contingent on these terms.

Non-compliance with these terms could result in revocation of Air Charity Network's assigned three-letter ICAO designator and telephony.
